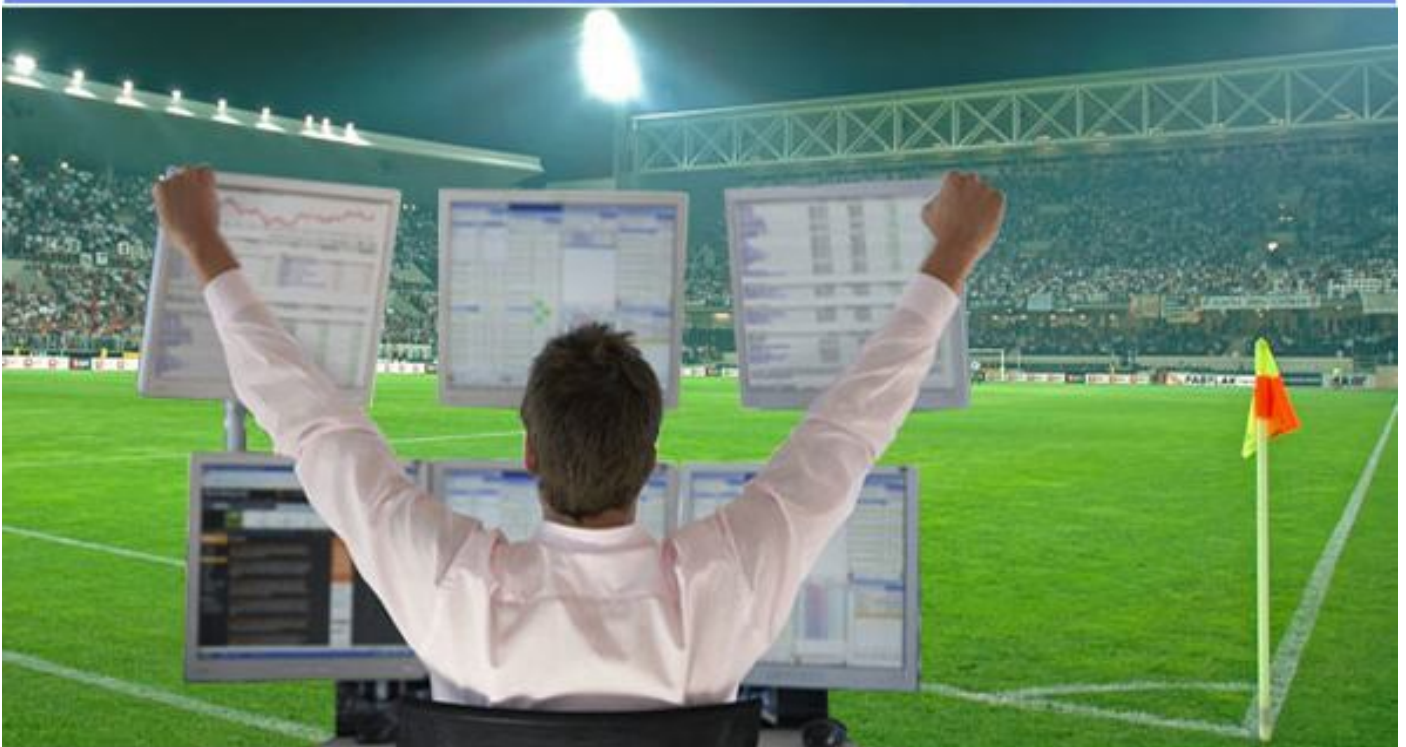

-The Service:

BetTrading is an online betting service where you trade along with the Professional Trader whilst a match is in-play, You will be told what to do and when to do it, and more importantly if the trade goes against you how to reduce your losses. Once you have joined you will be able to log into the trading room and trade along with our professional trader on his recommended trades.

We suggest following our service for long-term periods. You should not rely on one day or one week results. As this is a long-term service, you should consider it as a mid or long-term investment.

-How can I register?

Registration is easy and straight forward. You only need to click on register button and fill out all required fields. Once the request is submitted and you pay the service, you will have full access to the daily live tips.

Data provided by the user must be correct. Otherwise, the application will be eventually rejected.

-How does the service work?

Once you are a registered user, you have to log in with your user ID and password to check new tips and their results. Tips of the day will be loaded at least two hours before the relevant match kicks off. You will be notified by e-mail every time a new tip is available. However, you will need to log-in in order to read the complete information. You will need to be logged in during the whole live match in order to place your bets properly.

-What sports do you tip?

Tips are generally related to soccer and tennis events. However, we are open to bet on any other event that we consider profitable. All kind of sports may be tipped.

-Am I allowed to share o resell tips?

Definitely not, we have intellectual property rights on the website. The information contained on the site cannot be shared, sold, or rented without our permission.

All the content is protected by intellectual laws and any infringement to our conditions and terms will be penalized. We provide an honest service, so we need honest customers. We will have no tolerance with anybody who breaks our rules resulting in account closure and damage compensation request in case of fraud. If you suspect somebody is plagiarizing our services, please report them immediately at info@BetTrading.com

-What bookmakers should I be registered with?

We advice our users to have betting accounts with at least two bookmakers. One of them should be a betting exchange site such as [Betfair](#), Betdaq, Wbx, Betsson, BetBull, etc. This is due to the fact that you can usually find higher odds at betting exchange sites than you do at traditional betting sites which it will pay off in the long run.

It is also recommended to be registered with a traditional bookmaker, in case any odds-related problem or difficulty arises on the betting exchange site

-How much does your service cost?

You can see the prices in our website, in "Subscription" menu.

-Can I check your sales records and annual profits?

Yes, you can check our investment and financial progress.

-¿What is the recommended Stake?

Usually we will invest 100 units for each event.

Tip services:***LiveTrading tips:**

One or more bets are placed before a sport event start, either back or lay bets. More bets may be placed 'in-running' during the sport event in order to guarantee a profit even before it finishes.

You will receive a sound and visual alert every time a new bet is to be placed. In order to use our 'in-running tips' service you will need to be logged-in and to check the 'tip-detail' during the sport event.

Trading positions are always taken when odds are not at their peak (after a goal scored, during a break, etc). Thus, all customers can place their bets with no problem due to the lower volatility.

Note that we will not trade out unless we have guaranteed a profit of 15% or more for us. Therefore, do not hesitate if we recommend you to bet at 1,50 odds, meanwhile the market only offers you 1,48, 1,46, 1,44. It's quite usual that odds slightly fluctuate in betting exchange houses.

It is necessary to have a minimum of 150 units available in order to make a profitable use of our in-running tip service.

We bet 50 units backing over 1.5 goals, 1,42 odds in a football match. With the match already in-play and once the first goal has been scored we lay 58 units of over 1,5 goals, 1,24 odds, risking 13.92 units. Thus, we trade out guaranteeing a profit before the match finishes.

On live trading tips the goal is to trade out with profits before the sport event ends or to minimize the losses if things do not go our way. Bet-tips will be displayed on the website at all times.

We highly recommend you to visit a betting exchange site help section to clearly understand back and lay bets as well as some other concepts you may not be familiar with.

In this section you can monitor the tips loaded-up for the current day. This may be helpful if you want to follow the evolution of several live tips at the same time. You can print out our daily tips by setting up the page horizontally.

***Members area, personal data (You must be logged-in).**

In this section you can update your personal data, change passwords, languages, etc. You can also decide whether you want to keep receiving tips by e-mail.

IMPORTANT:

When you exit from your account is absolutely essential that you do by clicking the text "Close Session".

***Glossary:**

Stake: Amount of money risked on a bet.

Bankroll: Total available resources to bet, which should be properly managed since they will increase or fall depending on our results.

Odds: Number / price that indicates the probability of something to happen. The higher the odds the higher the potential return. There are three kind of betting odds: Decimal, Fractional, and American.

Lay bet (LAY): A bet against something to happen.

Back bet (BACK): A bet on something to happen.

Total risk, money at risk: It is the total amount we can lose if our bet is not a winner.

Back bets refer to the money wagered.

Lay bets are calculated from:

Total risk= (Odd x Money wagered)-Money wagered.

Total bet: Total amount of money wagered.

Exchange sites: Betting sites where the owner offers a platform to punters allowing them to cross their bets and charging a commission on the winnings.

Losses: Risked and lost money. Losses may vary depending on the kind of bet placed: Back or lay.

And the difference is as follows:

In case of a lost back bet, the loss is as follows:

Loses= Money wagered

Meanwhile, in a failed lay bet is:

Loses= Money risked.

Profits: It is the difference between the amount of money risked and the amount earned.

They vary depending on the type of bet placed.

On back bets, won profits are as follows:

Profit = (Money wagered x Odd) – Money wagered.

Whereas on lay bets:

Profit= Money wagered.

Total balance:= Profit - Loss.

Yield%=(Total balance / Total risk)***100**

Trading: A betting technique inspired on the stock market. Back and lay bets are placed on a same event.

Back bets are usually placed at high odds whereas lay bets are placed at lower odds. As these markets fluctuate, the target is to guarantee a profit, no matter what the final score will be.

Tip: A piece of advice from an expert who deeply analyzes statistics, trends, injuries, suspensions, weather conditions and any related issue that could affect the outcome of a sport event.

Dutching: To risk a specific stake on each possible result looking for a guaranteed profit whatever happens in the sport

event.
